

## **Safety Protocol for September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020**

The health and safety of our Patrons, Artists and Staff is extremely important to us.

As such, all Visitors should be aware of the following.

**Due to COVID-19 we are operating at reduced capacity.**

**Our seating plan includes physical distancing, up to 25 patrons.**

**If you are feeling unwell the day of event, please cancel your reservation and stay home.**

Feeling unwell includes, but is not limited to, respiratory issues (cough, running nose, fever, shortness of breath).

**Please DO NOT attend if you have travelled to another country or any part of Canada outside of western Canada or northwestern Ontario in the last 14 days.**

**Please follow these protocols for your safety and ours:**

- Wearing a face mask is required. Face masks must cover the mouth, nose and chin.
- Patrons will be required to complete screening for COVID-19 following Manitoba Health screening tool, contact tracing information will be collected.
- While waiting for entry, visitors are requested to line up in the hallway with physical distancing of at least 6 feet.
- Ushers will guide audience in/out to ensure one-way traffic flow.
- Patrons are requested to seat in assigned seats.

**Hygiene protocols:**

- Visitors are requested to sanitize their hands before entry. Hand sanitizer is available at the door and throughout our spaces.
- If you cough or sneeze in the theatre, use a tissue or into your bended elbow and sanitize your hands immediately afterwards.
- No shaking of hands, hugging, or touching unless of members of the same household.
- High touch points are cleaned before and after events.

Event runs 30 minutes. Seating available 15 minutes prior to start time.

Due to COVID-19 we are suspending the use of paper tickets and programs.

No concessions are available.
